13 graduates from Europaeum member universities attended alongside other participants selected by the Jagiellonian.


Europaeum Scholars Module 5, Barcelona

Our latest Scholars module took place in Barcelona in January 2019. We were hosted in the magnificent buildings of UPF and looked after extremely well by the UPF team working under the Vice-Rector Professor Isabel Valverde Zaragoza. This module focussed on developing the individual group projects further, as well as hearing from international experts on Euroscepticism and corruption within Politics, and first-hand reports by people affected by human trafficking, energy poverty, refugee problems, and women in gang environments. The Scholars participated in a workshop on Ethical Dilemmas in Leadership, and visited the Catalan Parliament.

The Scholars' projects are coming more and more into focus: One group is investigating Energy Poverty, another is looking at feedback mechanisms on online public consultation platforms (E-Democracy), and a third has been interviewing individuals who feel disconnected from the European Project about their 'Stories of Europe'. Our fourth group has just launched a social media campaign (You and EU) aimed at getting out the youth vote for the upcoming European elections.
