Arriving in Lisbon

From the Airport

Metro

If you are flying in to the Humberto Delgado Airport Lisbon, we suggest you take the Linha Vermelha of the Lisbon Metro. This metro line departs every 7 minutes and will take you to the station São Sebastião, from which it is a brief 12 minute walk to the hotel. In total, it should take you 30-35 minutes to get to the hotel via metro.




Please note: For the fare, you must purchase the '7 Colinas' / 'Viva Viagem' electronic travel card. This can be topped up with balance for your journeys and can be used both for the Metro and for the bus network. The 7 Colinas / Viva Viagem electronic card is priced at €0.50, with a single fare price being €1.45 and a 24H network pass costs €6.30 (at the time of writing).

Public buses

Buses stop outside at the airport arrivals terminal. You can take the 783 to Amoreiras (C. Comercial) and exit at Campo Pequeno - Av. República, to then switch over into the 52B to Sete Rios, which you would exit at Av. José Malhoa (Policia). It is then a 3 minute walk to the hotel, just down the road.




Alternatively, you can take the 722 to Praça De Londres and change at Av. João XXI / Pç. Londres into the 756 to Rua Da Junqueira, which you would then exit at Av. Calouste Gulbenkian. From there, it's only a brief 5 minute walk to the hotel, just down the road.



Please note that the maximum baggage size allowed in buses is 50x40x20cm. If your baggage exceeds that, you must take either the Aerobus or the Airport Shuttle. The fare on-board is €1.80.

Aerobus

There are multiple Aerobus routes. The Aerobus to Sete Rios runs from Lisbon Airport to the bus station at Sete Rios (Sete Rios Coach Terminal) from Monday to Friday except public holidays and will take you to the hotel in 25-35 minutes. From Sete Rios, it is a brief 11-minute walk to the hotel.



The Aerobus departs Lisbon Airport at 9 am, 10 am, 11 am, 12 pm, 3 pm, 4 pm and 5 pm. It departs Sete Rios for Lisbon Airport at 9.30 am, 10.30 am, 11.30 am, 12.30 pm, 3.30 pm, 4.30 pm and 5.30 pm.

A one-way ticket costs €4 (at the time of writing), and a round trip ticket valid for 120 days following the use of the outbound ticket costs €6. A 48 hour pass is priced at €8.

Taxi [for use only in extremis – we do not automatically reimburse taxi fares for students]

Taxis are normally queueing outside the departures and arrivals terminals. The journey to the hotel should cost between €10-20. Please note that luggage fees may be charged separately depending on the driver. If you choose to take a taxi, please make sure the meter is turned on at the beginning of the journey and ask for a receipt/invoice.
